1 RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text shall prevail.

2 ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3 ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International FJ-Class.
- 3.2 All competitors (helmsmen and crew) shall comply with the ISAF Eligibility Code.
- (3.3 Each crew member shall be member of a National FJ-Class Association affiliated to the National Authority.)
- 3.3 The entry fee will be JPY30,000 for each boat. Entry fees are not refundable.
- 3.4 The organizing authority must receive entry forms no later than June 1st 2015 via:

- 3.5 The maximum number of boats that will be accepted in this regatta is 80, first-come basis.
- 3.6. Competitors under 20 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration. The forms are available for download on the event website

6 REGISTRATION

9. COURSES:

The course configuration will be of the "triangle type".

10. INTERNATIONAL JURY:

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix N.

Its decisions will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

11 SCORING:

- 11.1 A maximum of 11 (eleven) races are scheduled.
- 11.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute the series and the Championship.
- 11.3 Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score if 6 or more races are completed in the event and excluding her two worst scores if 10 or more races are completed.

12 SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register, within the limit specified in NOR6 above, to the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

13 INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of JPY ¥50,000,000 (USD \$500,000) per incident or the equivalent.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 14.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 14.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 PRIZES:

The World Champion Trophy will be presented to the top placing team for the Overall.

Trophies will be presented to 1st to 6th places.
